# United Kingdom: involvement in EDCTP-funded collaborative research

More than **150** UK researchers



collaborate in a total of  
**103** EDCTP grants

The UK is the country with the highest participation in EDCTP grants. The country participates in 103 out of 281 EDCTP grants: 86 EDCTP1 grants, and 17 EDCTP2 grants. Moreover, the UK coordinates 35 out of 83 EDCTP grants that are led by a European researcher.

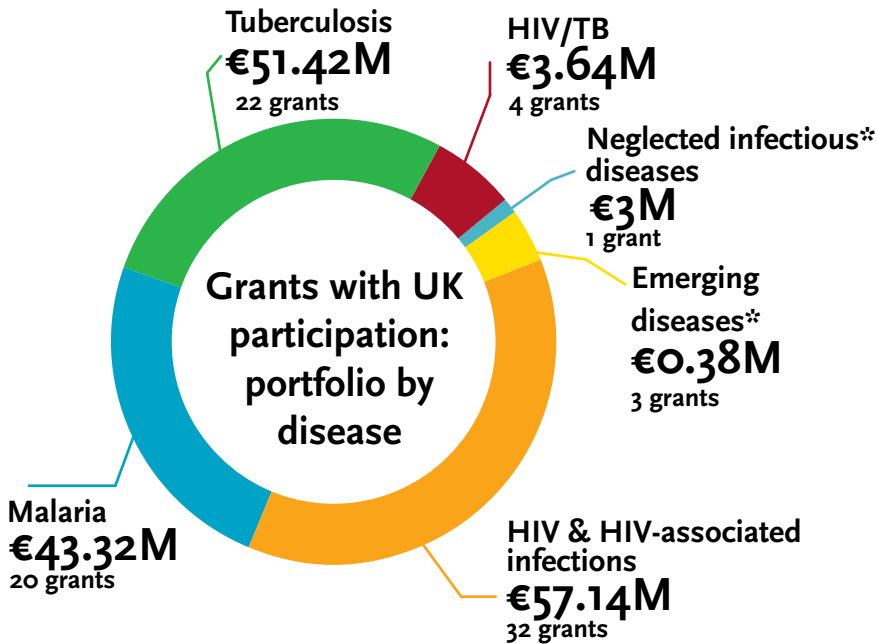

In addition to the portfolio by disease, 21 grants (€ 7.75M) have been awarded to projects with UK participation on topics such as ethics and regulatory support, capacity building, support to meetings, and other non-disease specific grants.

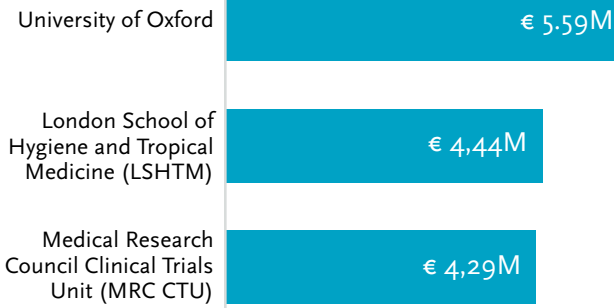

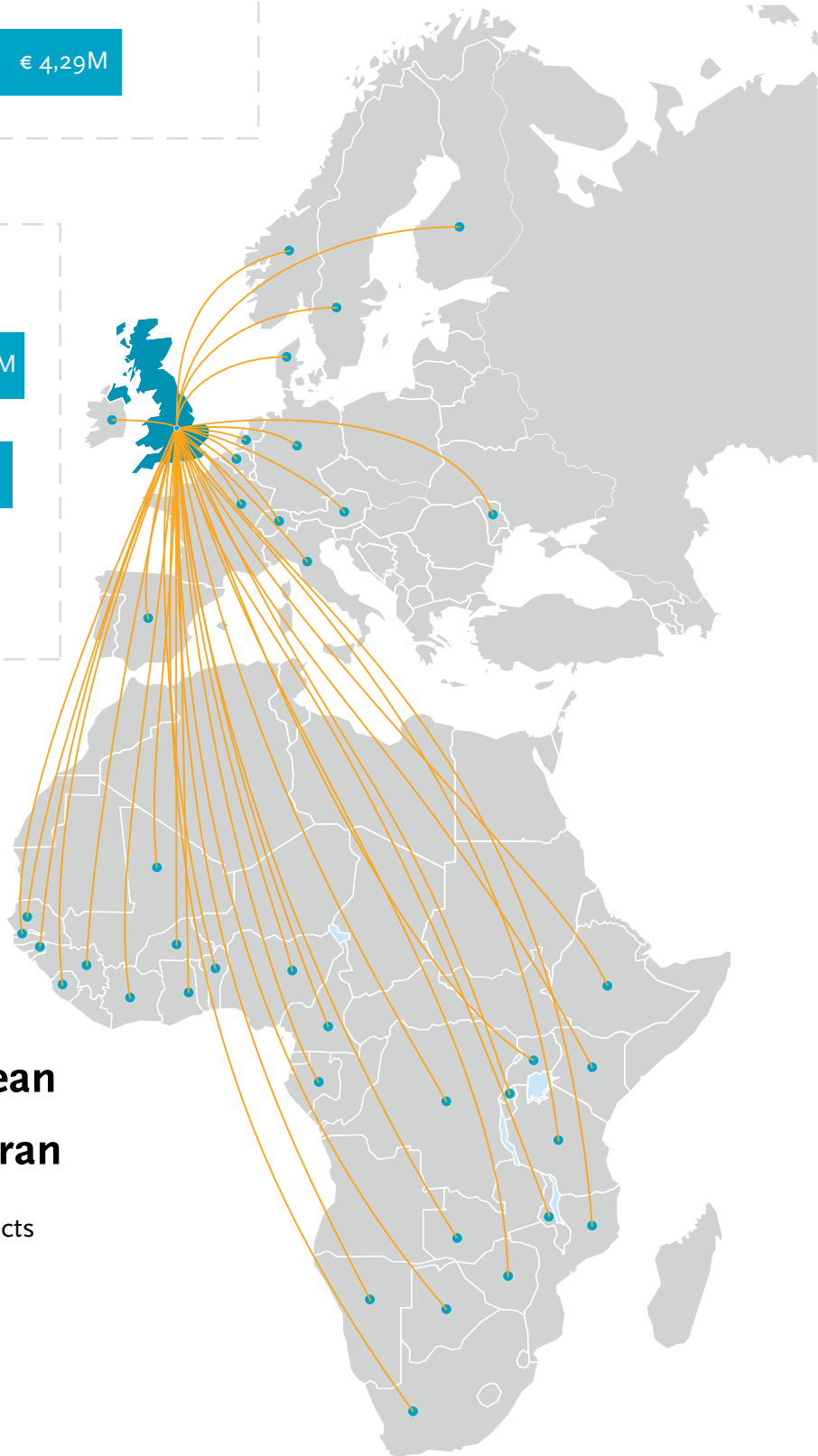
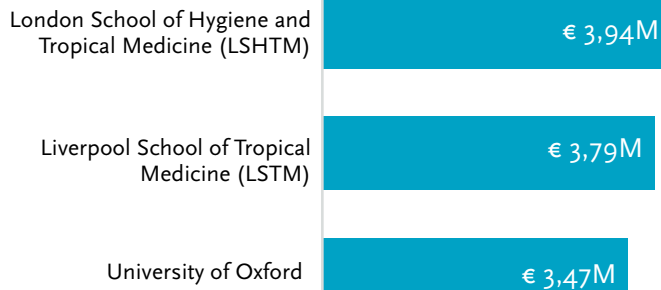
